The Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) presents his compliments to the Permanent Representatives and Observers to the United Nations and has the honour to transmit the following decision of the Committee:

The Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) decided on 31 March 2020 to extend the exemption to the travel ban imposed by paragraph 1 (b) of resolution 2255 (2015) for Abdul Ghani Baradar Abdul Ahmad Turk (TAi.024), Sher Mohammad Abbas Stanekzai Padshah Khan (TAi.067), Zia-ur-Rahman Madani (TAi.102), Abdul Salam Hanifi Ali Mardan Qul (TAi.027), Shahabuddin Delawar (TAi.113), Abdul Latif Mansur (TAi.007), Amir Khan Motaqi (TAi.026), Abdul-Haq Wasiq (TAi.082), Khairullah Khairkhwah (TAi.093), Nurullah Nuri (TAi.089), and Fazl Mohammad Mazloom (TAi.023), for a period of 90 days beginning on 31 March 2020 and ending on 29 June 2020.

The Chair further conveys to all Member States that the requested exemption was extended on the same terms as the travel ban exemption initially granted for the above-mentioned individuals (ref. SCA/14/19 (02) and SCA/14/19 (04)).
