The Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) presents his compliments to the Permanent Representatives and Observers to the United Nations and has the honour to transmit the following decision of the Committee:

The Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) decided on 23 June 2021 to extend the exemption to the travel ban imposed by paragraph 1 (b) of resolution 2255 (2015) for Abdul Kabir Mohammad Jan (TAi.003), Abdul Latif Mansur (TAi.007), Fazl Mohammad Mazloom (TAi.023), Abdul Ghani Baradar Abdul Ahmad Turk (TAi.024), Amir Khan Motaqi (TAi.026), Abdul Salam Hanafi Ali Mardan Qul (TAi.027), Din Mohammad Hanif (TAi.043), Sher Mohammad Abbas Stanekzai Padshah Khan (TAi.067), Abdul-Haq Wassiq (TAi.082), Nurullah Nuri (TAi.089), Khairullah Khairkhwah (TAi.093), Zia-Ur-Rahman Madani (TAi.102), Noor Mohammad Saqib (TAi.110) and Shahabuddin Delawar (TAi.113), for a period of 90 days beginning on 24 June 2021 and ending on 22 September 2021.

The Chair further conveys to all Member States that the requested exemption was extended on the same terms as the travel ban exemption initially granted for the above-mentioned individuals (ref. SCA/14/19 (02), SCA/14/19 (04), SCA/14/20 (01), SCA/14/20 (03), SCA/14/20 (06), SCA/14/20 (07), SCA/14/20 (08)) and SCA/14/21 (04)).
